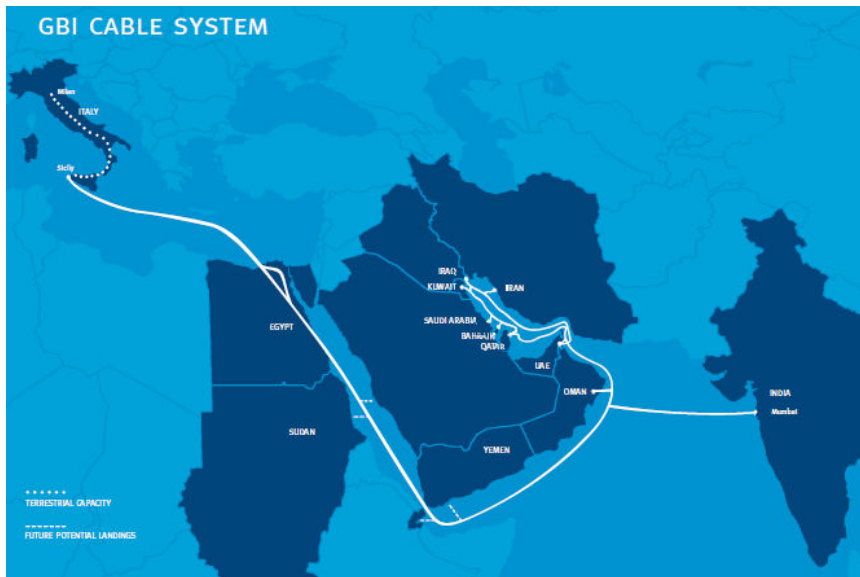


GULF BRIDGE INTERNATIONAL AT ITW 2009

Gulf Bridge International ('GBI') will be present at ITW 2009 in Washington DC, introducing their first undersea cable system: **Gulf Bridge International Cable System ('GBICS')**. GBICS will connect all the nations of the Gulf to one another and to the rest of the world East & West, using the latest fiber optic and DWDM technologies.

About GBI: A GCC company, GBI intends to be carrier independent and will not compete with operators or service providers for their clients. Operating only at the transport level, GBI's objective is to become a preferred



supplier of advanced wholesale international undersea connectivity products to telecoms operators and other users of international capacity around the Gulf region with higher reliability and lower cost.

GBI will provide intra-regional capacity within the Gulf and international capacity to Europe and India, with three distinct product offerings: SDH (STM₁ to STM₆₄), Wavelength (10 Gb/s), and Ethernet (1GigE and 10GigE).

About GBICS: The high capacity ring network employs double landings at the major terminals of Qatar, and Fujairah (UAE) with branched landings in Iran, Iraq, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, and Oman. The network will include dedicated GBI express fiber connectivity direct to Europe and India.

The landings at Fujairah in the UAE and Al Seeb in Oman, where a number of other international cable systems land, will provide GBI with ready access to international connectivity on other cable systems, which will give it a number of options for providing its wholesale customers with connectivity to the full range of global destinations in Europe, North America and Asia. Carriers with capacity on SEAMEWE 3, SEAMEWE 4, IMEWE, EIG, MENA, or TW-1 will be able to connect to any Gulf destination with GBI.
